THE PASSCHENDAEELE ARCHIVES

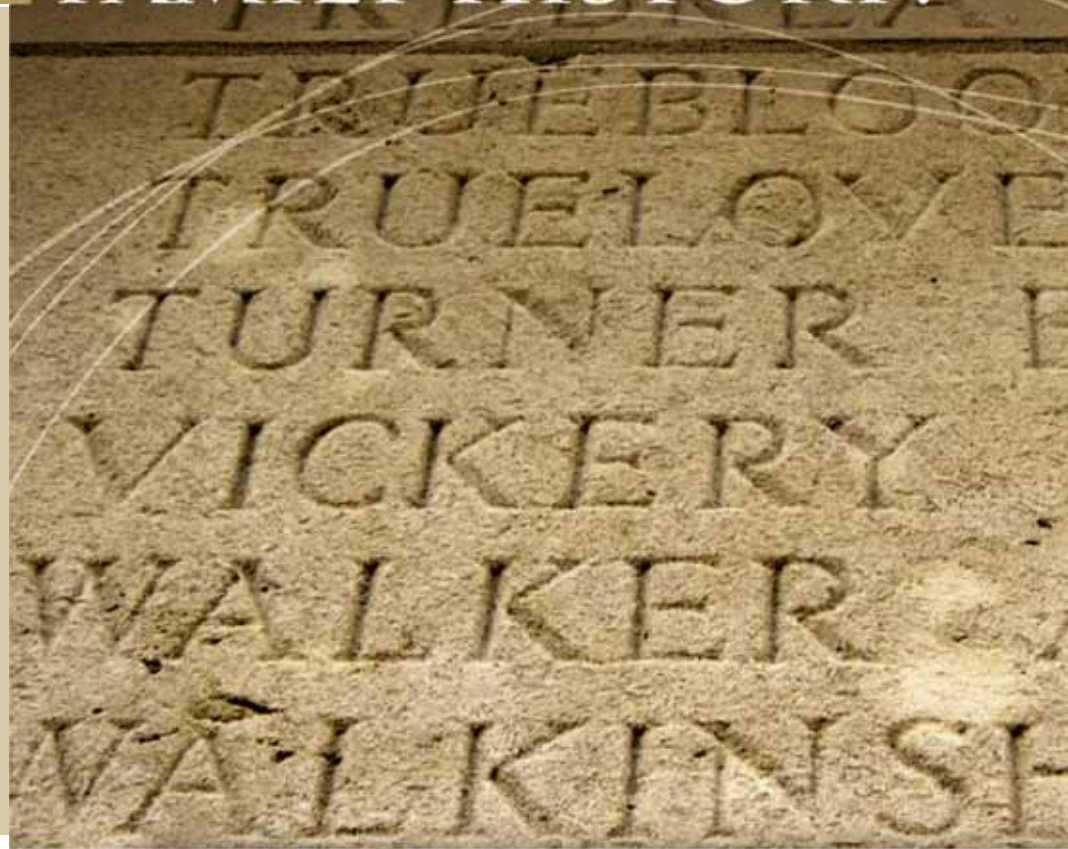
The Passchendaele Archives is a project of the Memorial Museum Passchendaele 1917. It started in 2005 and is ongoing. The museum commemorates the Battle of Passchendaele 1917 and is located in the Zonnebeke château grounds. It is the ideal starting point for a visit to the battlefields of 1914-1918 and especially of 1917. The first floor offers an historical overview of the Great War. Part of the museum is the unique dugout experience with underground headquarters, sleeping benches, communication post and dressing station.
